****7th and 8th Graders:**

Future Notre Dame Academy Students: NDA will highly recommend, if not require, the purchase of either a TI-83 or TI-84 graphing calculator in high school. Because of this, it is highly recommended (but not required) that all 7th and 8th graders purchase a TI-83 or TI-84 Calculator. It would be very beneficial to have your own calculator to learn on and use.

Future De Pere High School Students: You will more than likely be required to purchase the TI- Nspire calculator in high school. If you would like to wait and purchase this calculator in high school, Ms. Norppa will have a few TI-83 calculators that can be used **for classroom use only**. If you do this, at least keep a scientific calculator with you so you have one to always use at your disposal. I do not recommend buying the TI-Nspire calculator now. They are expensive and delicate and the features of this calculator will not be utilized in middle school.

****6th Graders:** 6th grade students will be fine purchasing a scientific calculator or even just a basic calculator. Ms. Norppa recommends the scientific calculator TI-30X IIS. However, if you would like to plan ahead for future years, and save a few dollars in the long run, see the 7th and 8th grade note about the TI-83, TI-84 or TI-Nspire calculators. Purchasing one of these calculators now will keep your student set with a calculator for years to come. Ms. Norppa still has the TI-83 she has used for 12 years!
