

# NOTRE DAME OF DE PERE \$CRIP PROGRAM

\$CRIP is a gift card program... you are rewarded for spending money where you already shop! Simply purchase gift cards online, through your phone, or the \$CRIP office and earn 1% rebate for Notre Dame and toward your \$CRIP commitment (\$250 for K through 8<sup>th</sup> families; no minimum for early childhood-only families); thereafter you earn 1% rebate for Notre Dame, with the remaining rebate percentage going toward your family tuition. Tuition credit is applied in January and June.

Note: If you choose not to participate in \$CRIP, you may “buyout” the minimum commitment during school enrollment and it will be added to your tuition plan. If you participate in the program and do not generate the minimum \$250 in profits, you will be responsible for the difference between what your purchases generate and \$250.

**For the 2016-17 school year, the school, parishes, and school families earned over \$70,000 in net profits!! Your family can also save hundreds of dollars on tuition!** The percentage for each retailer varies and ranges from 1% to 24%. The average is 5%.

Example of how it works after meeting minimum requirement (rebate amounts current as of Dec 2017):

- **Grocery:** Festival Foods rebate is 3% - 1% to NDDP, 2% to your tuition
- **Gas:** Grand Central Station/Shell rebate is 10% - 1% to NDDP, and 9% to your tuition
- **Clothing and Home Goods:** Kohl’s rebate is 4% - 1% to NDDP, and 3% to your tuition
- **Clothing:** Under Armour rebate is 11% - 1% to NDDP, and 10% to your tuition
- **Travel (Airlines):** American Airlines rebate is 6% - 1% to NDDP, 5% to your tuition
- **Travel (Hotels, Rental Cars, etc.):** Intercontinental rebate is 9% - 1% to NDDP, 8% to your tuition

If a family purchases \$400 in groceries, \$200 in gas, and \$100 in home goods gift cards from examples above, the school would earn \$7 and your family would earn \$29 tuition credits. Some families save 1-2 monthly tuition payments!!

**Purchases of SCRIP can be made for the 2017-18 school year until the morning of April 30. Anything purchased after this time will be credited to the 2018-19 school year.**

**Important update to 2018-19 Program!**

In order to streamline program administration and improve access to online reporting for families, we are shifting to a new program format next year (effective May 1, 2018):

- No change to minimum requirement (\$250 for K-8 families; not applicable to Early Childhood-only families).
- Upon meeting minimum, 80% profit earned to family tuition, with remaining 20% of profit earned to NDDP.

Applying new structure to family example above, \$7.20 profit would go to school (compared to \$7.00 previously) and \$28.80 to families tuition (compared to \$29.00 previously).
